Treasurer's Report was approved with a balance of \$ 2852.83.

Old Business:

- A. Mrs. Claus Bazaar – The Bazaar was slow this year. There was about 1 dozen plates of baked good left. Next year we would like to see the baked goods labeled. Leftovers were donated to city groups. Scrip should be made available next year. It was missed this year. \$886.82 was made.
- B. Santa Breakfast – \$97.00 was made on pictures. \$604.00 was made from the food. There was a good turnout for breakfast. A mistake was made with the order. There were two account numbers given so we received the order twice. This totaled \$565.00. The extras will be able to be used for the next breakfast. Extra freezer space was offered by Chris Geldhof if needed for the food. The ad we placed did not seem to bring in the public. Next year we will advertise earlier and better. We will also get it in the church bulletin earlier.
- C. Santa's Workshop – There was good feedback from the workshop. The children enjoyed shopping. We will plan on doing the shopping again next year and leave Fun Services as a backup. We will plan on getting volunteers and teachers schedules coordinated earlier next year for less confusion. We made \$1356 with \$602 going to Fun Services and 603 going for things we purchased. There was approximately \$100.00 profit. There are also over 200 items in storage for use next year.
- D. Catholic Schools Week – January 31st will kick off Catholic School's Week. The breakfast will be that morning. It will be offered after 8:30 mass only. Father Tom requested rolls and coffee after the 11:00 mass. Julie Palmer will take care of that. It was decided for the VIP luncheon to serve a taco bar. February 4th will be VIP day. Jodi Walczak is willing to donate 10 pounds of meat. Julie Kubiak will call Ellen Fitzpatrick to see about getting the other. Julie Palmer will take care of the flyer. Lunch will be \$2.00 per person. Donna went over supplies needed. The talent show will be held February 5th. Family School Council will take care of the continental breakfast.
- E. Book Fair – Tracy Miller will be heading this up. She will need 7 tables brought up Thursday night for setup. The 8th graders will be asked to do this. A note will go home with the Catholic Schools Week information.

It was suggested tickets should sell for approximately \$5.00 for adults and \$3.00 for children.
